

Create tab Admission (put the following information in admission tab)

From the academic year 2020-21 the institute is affiliated with IITE as per Government of Gujarat order. Hence, the admission procedure is changed. The new admission procedure is as follow.

Please be ready with documents like Marksheets, LC, Caste Certificate, Non-creamy layer certificate, PH certificate in PDF format (51 kb to 2 Mb size) before starting the process.

Step 1 : Go to the website : www.iite.ac.in

Step 2 : Click on admission tab and select admission brochure option or click the link <https://www.iite.ac.in/downloads/iite-admission-2020-information>

Step 3 : click on IITE admission brochure 2020 option to download the information booklet. Or click on the link <https://iite.ac.in/download/notice/5ee0f878d37b9.pdf>

Step 4 : Study the information booklet carefully.

Step 5 : Again go to admission tab and select online application for admission 2020 option to start application procedure. Or click the link <http://portal.iite.ac.in/core-emli/online-admission/portal/online-adm-portal/index.php#/>

Step 6 : Select B.Ed. from dropdown menu titled select programme.

Step 7 : Enter your mobile number. And click on send OTP option.

Step 8 : Insert OTP to process further.
